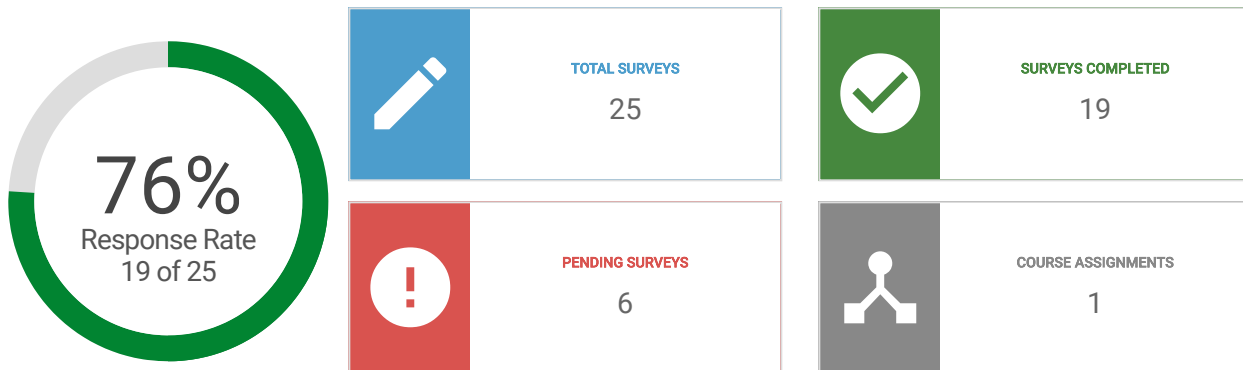

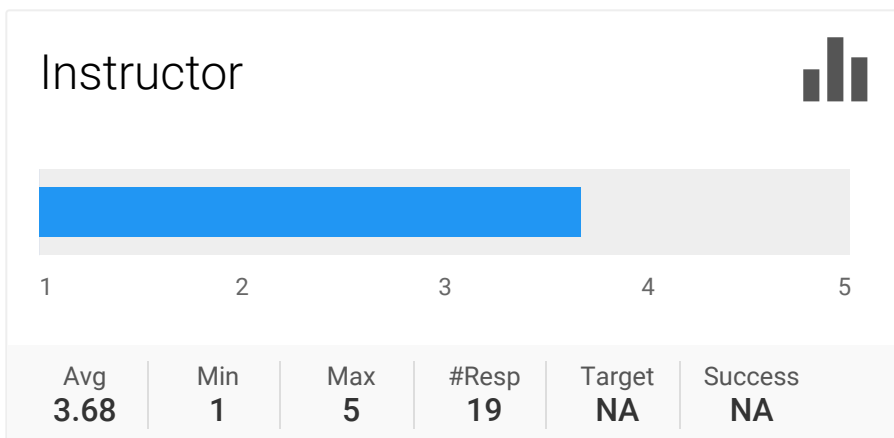

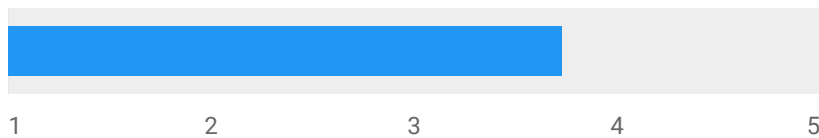
### Survey Overview / Course Section Results Aggregate
